

TIME TO VOTE!

The Massachusetts State Election is Tuesday,
November 6th Polls are open 7am to 8pm at Ashby
Elementary School

ABSENTEE BALLOTS are available for the State Election. If you are physically unable to get out to the polls on election day, or are going to be out of town that day, you can still vote. The process is simple! Request an application for yourself or a relative by calling the Town Clerk's office (978) 386-2424 ext.10. Ballots can be mailed back but must arrive by the close of the polls on Election Day.

EARLY VOTING FOR THE STATE ELECTION WILL BE AVAILABLE TO ALL MASSACHUSETTS VOTERS. No reason is required. You may cast your early ballot in person at the Town Clerk's office October 22 through November 1st: Monday-Friday 8am-12pm and Wednesday evenings 5-8pm October 22 through November 1.

Ashby P.D. Tip of the Month:

PERSONAL SAFETY TIPS REGARDING YOUR HOME AND VEHICLE:

- Make sure all exterior doors and windows are secured.
- If you will be returning after dark, have an interior light set on a timer so when you come home there will be a light on in your home.
 - Don't leave notes on your door when you're not home.
- Never leave a house key under the doormat, in a flowerpot, or on the ledge of the door.
- Garage doors should always be kept closed and locked—even if you are home.
- If you have a garage, use it. Lock your car and make sure your garage is secured.
- If you have to park in your driveway, don't leave your garage remote control in plain view and lock your car.
 - Don't leave valuables or packages inside your parked car where they can be seen.
