This free blood pressure clinic is offered by the Nashoba Associated Boards of Health as a public health program. We invite you to drop by the blood pressure clinic to meet with your town nurse, have your blood pressure checked and learn more about town health services and wellness checks.

MEDICARE UPDATE:

It's that time of year again! If you are enrolled in a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan or a Medicare Advantage Plan (HMO/ PPO), expect a packet from your plan by the end of September. It is important to understand and save this information as it explains the changes in your plan for 2019. Premiums, deductibles, co-pays, and the drugs covered by your plan can change significantly!



During Medicare Open Enrollment, you can adjust your plan for next year. SHINE Counselors help you understand your plan changes as well as other options you may have. Call now to discuss your insurance questions, schedule your SHINE phone or face-to-face appointment, or learn about group meetings during the Open Enrollment from October 15 through December 7th!

REMINDER: Be on the alert for your new Medicare card in the mail and as always, bring your card and drug list to your appointment!



The SHINE Program provides FREE, unbiased, health insurance counseling to all Mass residents with Medicare, their caregivers, and those approaching Medicare eligibility.


