

June 19, 2019 The Hearing was opened at 8:04 for 197 Harris Road. Chris MacKenzie from Ducharme & Dillis presented this project for a septic system replacement. This property is owned by Steve Buczynski and is located across from the property being purchased by the town.

The existing system has failed. The engineering firm as designed a presby system for this project. There is an intermittent stream and associated bordering vegetative wetland on the Fish and Wildlife land which abuts the property. The fill for the system enters the buffer zone for that wetland.

The fill will end within a foot or two of the property line. The fill is graded and becomes the base for a swale that will be grassed and graded toward the back of the property.

The grassed swale – Should be seeded from the direction of F&W land so that the seed stays on the Buczynski side of the wall. Straw wattles to be changed to mulch wattles.

Plan to leave the benchmark tree and attempt not to bury the roots too deeply.

There is no DEP number for the project, so the Commission cannot close the hearing. Hopefully, continuing the hearing to July 2nd will allow enough time for DEP to issue a project number. A motion was made and 2nd to continue the hearing to July 2nd, 2019 @7:45pm. The Vote was unanimous in favor of the motion.

The hearing was continued at 8:24pm.
